Summary of Work

The Contract 1 contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., received Notice to Proceed on November 29, 2010 and construction was substantially complete on December 19, 2011. Construction required significant coordination with abutters, with other utilities for relocations, and with other contractors working on different contracts for the project in adjacent areas.

The contractor replaced or rehabilitated four outfalls to the Reserved Channel. The outfalls are located on Pappas Way (076), adjacent to I Street (078), on the Summer Street Bridge (079) and at Conley Terminal (080). The work also included pipe installation to connect the outfalls to drains in the

street at three of the outfalls. Temporary restoration of impacted roadways has been completed. Permanent restoration will be scheduled for the spring. Remaining landscaping restoration will also be completed in the spring.

Ongoing construction in the vicinity of F Street, I Street, East First Street and West First Street is related to Contracts 3A and 3B.

We would like to thank you for your patience and understanding during the construction of Contract 1 of the Reserved Channel Sewer Separation Project. The improvements will benefit our customers with improved drainage systems and better water quality in Boston Harbor.
