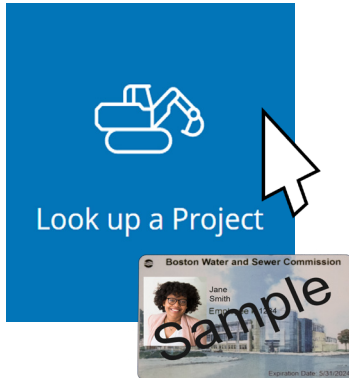

Celebrate Earth Day With Greener Stormwater Solutions



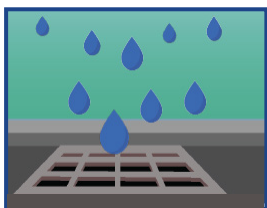
Grants of up to \$8,000.00 are available to property owners through the Green Stormwater Infrastructure Assistance Grant Program!

A credit of up to 50% is available for customers that meet the standards for stormwater retention and infiltration systems on their property.

Also, a 5% credit is available for educational programs that promote stormwater management practices.

Age Strong's 2026 Cost-Savings Clinics

Clinics to support older adults in accessing money saving resources.

Mayor Wu and the City of Boston's Age Strong Commission will host free in-person cost-savings clinics to assist Boston's older residents (age 55+) to help lower everyday expenses like fuel assistance, home repair, water/sewer discounts, property tax relief, SNAP, Senior Circuit Breaker Tax Credit, Medicare Savings Program and more. BWSC offers a 30% discount on the water, sewer, and stormwater portion of the bill to homeowners age 65 and older or disabled. Call Age Strong at 617-635-4366 Monday-Friday 9 to 5 and an Age Strong Advocate will assist you in making an appointment.
